

Privacy statement Pim van Lommel

Pim van Lommel attaches great importance to protecting the privacy of its customers and visitors. Pim van Lommel therefore ensures that the personal information you provide us with is confidential and careful being treated. By providing your personal data to Pim van Lommel (via the webshop, email or otherwise) you agree that Pim van Lommel will have your data in accordance with the Privacy Statement used.

1. Responsibility for your data

Pim van Lommel, located in Velp, the Netherlands, is responsible for the processing of personal data of its customers and visitors.

2. What data do we process about you?

- A. If we receive your data via the webshop, e-mail, post or otherwise, we will process the following data from you:
 - a. Name
 - b. Address
 - c. Residence
 - d. telephone number
 - e. E-mail address
- B. Contact History
 - a. We process data about the contact you had with us:
 - b. What was the contact about (purchase in webshop or question).
 - c. When was the contact and with whom.
 - d. How (via mail, our webshop, e-mail, app)

We use these contact details to improve our services.

3. What do we use your personal data for?

- A. Execution of the agreement
With your personal data we can, for example:
 - Contact you.
 - Capture your interest in our products.
 - Entering into and executing an agreement with you.
 - Put your data in our records and update it if there are changes.
- B. Reduce risks
We share responsibility for the safety of you, us and our customers. Our measures include:
- C. Laws and regulations
Pim van Lommel acts in accordance with the applicable laws and regulations, such as on privacy:
 - a. Provide good security. Think of usernames, passwords and security questions.

- b. And we invest in resources that protect you and us against all kinds of crime.
 - c. Internal quality research into possible problems and risks and testing whether legislation is correct has been entered.
- D. Laws and regulations
Pim van Lommel acts in accordance with applicable laws and regulations such as privacy:
 - d. General Data Processing Regulation (GDPR) (from May 25, 2018)
 - e. Telecommunications Act (becomes e-privacy regulation)

4. What is the legal basis or legal basis for using your personal data?

Consent: before Pim van Lommel processes your data, she will ask for your permission. Execution of agreement: entering into and / or executing a contract. Legitimate interest of Pim van Lommel to carry out (limited) marketing activities.

5. How do we take care of your data?

We handle your information with great care.

- A. Security
We have taken technical and organizational measures to protect your data from loss or unlawful processing. This includes measures for our website and IT systems safe to use and prevent misuse. But also to the security of areas where data is stored, information security policies and training of our employees.
- B. Confidentiality
All our employees have signed a confidentiality agreement. We handle with care information that you entrust to us. And only authorized personnel may view your data and process.

6. How long do we keep your data?

Pim van Lommel does not store your data longer than necessary. Laws other than the GDPR, such as tax legislation and the Civil Code can prescribe terms that Pim van Lommel complies with prevalent cases.

7. Who can we share your information with?

Pim van Lommel does not provide personal data to third parties, unless we have permission from you. or if permitted or necessary by law or in case of fraud.

8. Email and Social Media

- A. Social Media
You can choose to chat with us, contact us through our social media pages such as Facebook, LinkedIn and Twitter or via WhatsApp. If you approach us through one of these channels, keep it we store this information in a secure environment. To be able to respond to personal questions in your social media message we ask for your details in a personal message (direct message or e-mail) to share with us. We can then check whether we are talking to the right person.
- B. This privacy statement applies to the information we receive from you via these platforms. It use of social media itself is your own responsibility. This privacy statement does not belong to applies to how social media platforms handle the data you provide. We would like to point out that many social media platforms are located outside the European Union and store data outside of the European Union. The privacy legislation of the European Union usually does not apply. We recommend that you to carefully read the privacy statement of these social media channels.

9. What are your rights?

- A. View or correct data
You have the right to ask us which personal data we process about you and to request incorrect ones have data modified or deleted. If you want to view your data, we will issue this pass when we have sufficient certainty that you are who you say you are. That's what we propose control questions.

Send a request for inspection or correction to Pim van Lommel (details at the bottom of this statement). Please enclose a copy of your ID. You can add your passport photo and make citizen service number (BSN) invisible. We recommend that you indicate on the copy, for which it is intended. You will receive a response from us within four weeks.
- B. Have data deleted and the right to "be forgotten". You have it in the following situations right to have the data we have about you erased:
 - a. the personal data are no longer necessary for the purposes for which they were collected or otherwise processed;
 - b. consent for processing has been withdrawn;
 - c. a well-founded objection has been made to the processing;
 - d. the personal data has been processed unlawfully;
 - e. on the basis of a legal obligation to delete the personal data.
- C. Restriction of Processing
If you believe that we are processing your data unlawfully or that we have processed it data is incorrect, you can request a restriction of the processing. This means that the data may no longer be processed.
- D. Transfer of the data (data portability)
You have the right to receive a copy of the information you have provided to us.

10. Adjustment of the privacy statement

We can adjust this privacy statement. We can do this with new developments, for example if there are something changes in our business activities or in the law or in case law. We therefore recommend this one to view the privacy statement regularly when you visit our webshop. This text is last amended on March 21, 2018.
